



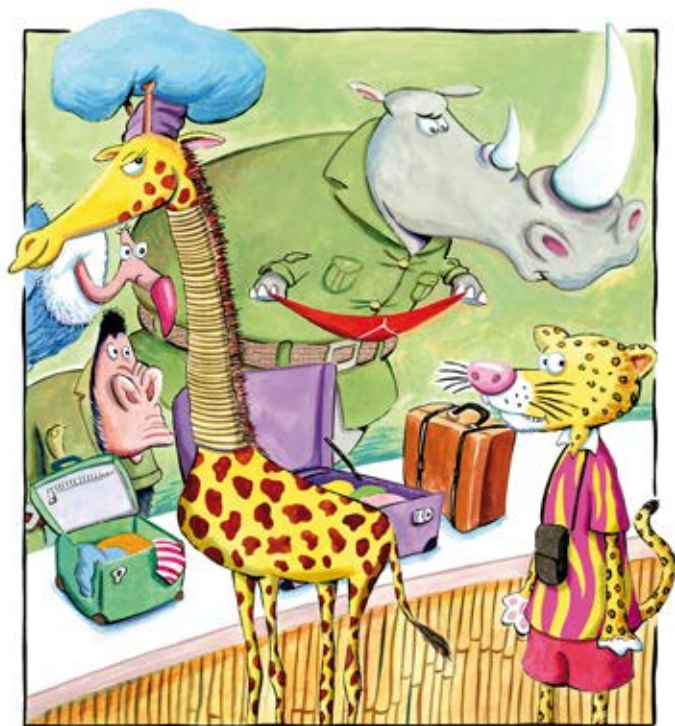
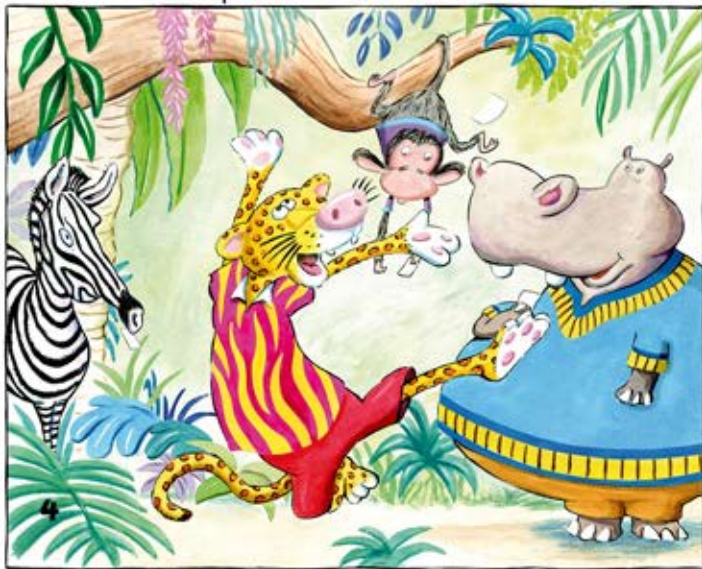
Leonardo's Spot of Trouble

The Tourist Spots

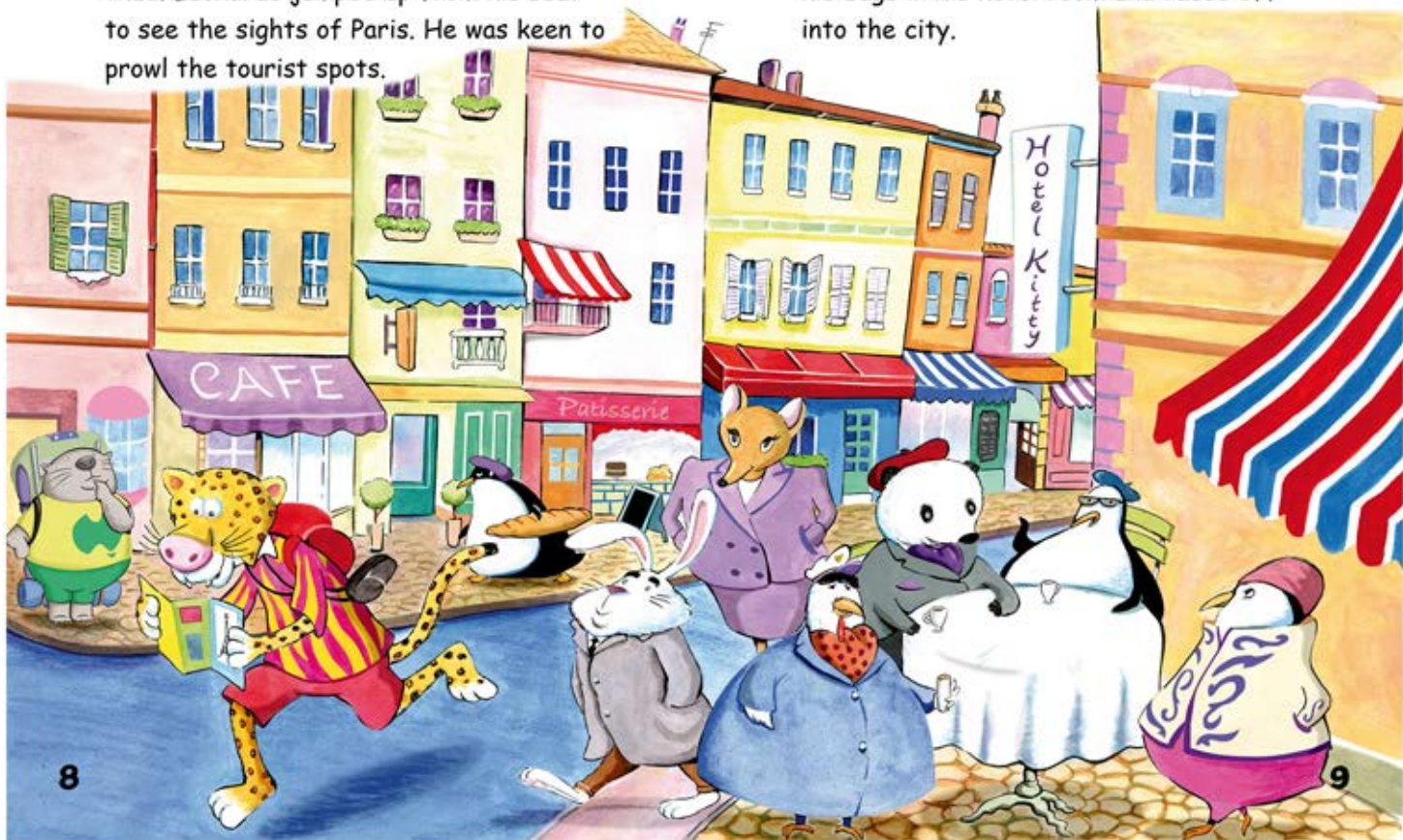
Leonardo the leopard went wild with glee. He had just won a prize in the jungle raffle and was going to France! He packed his bags in a hurry and set off for the airport.

Leonardo went to the Kitty Hotel. He left his bags in his hotel room and raced off into the city.



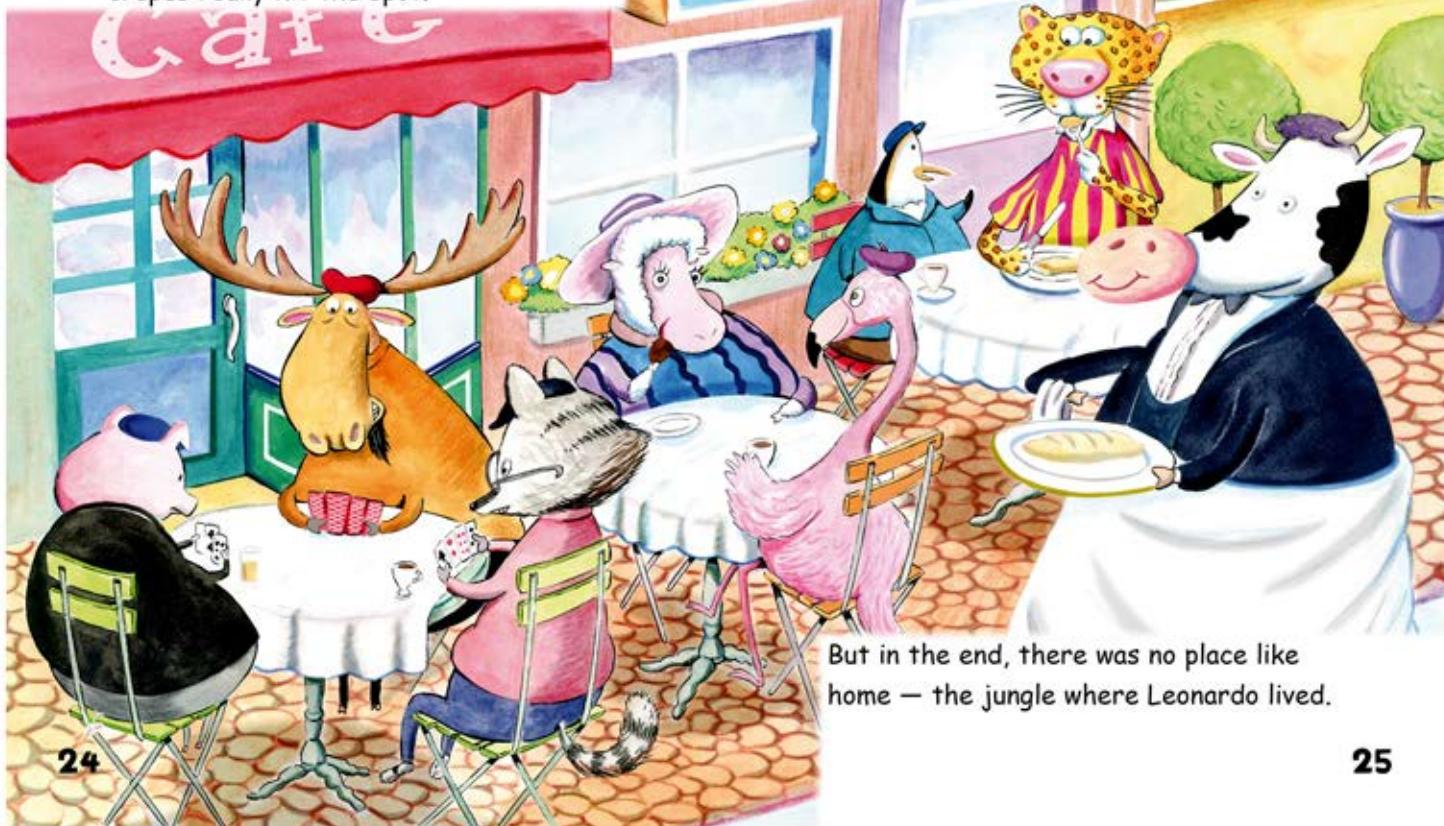


Alarm bells rang! The police pounced!
