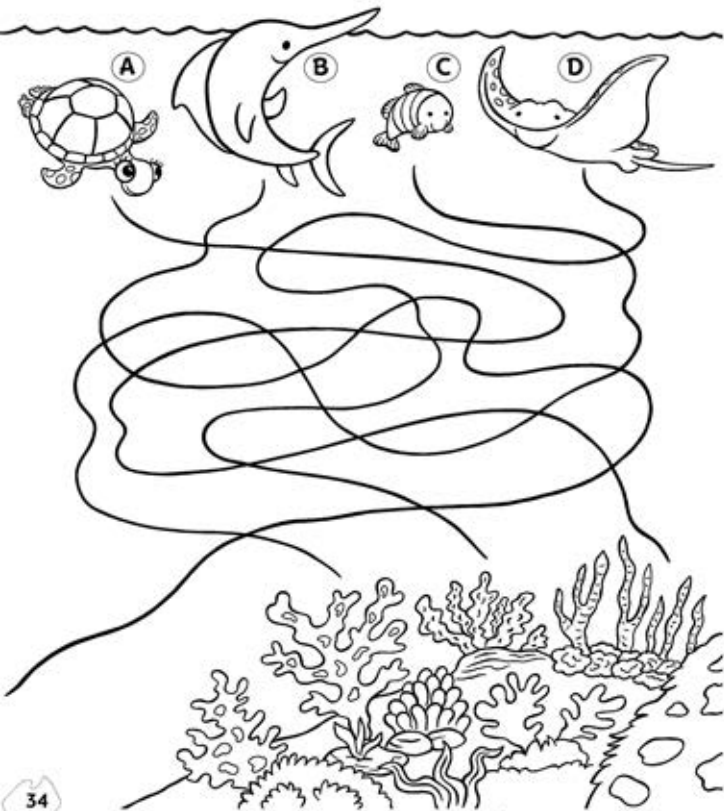

## Barrier Reef rumble

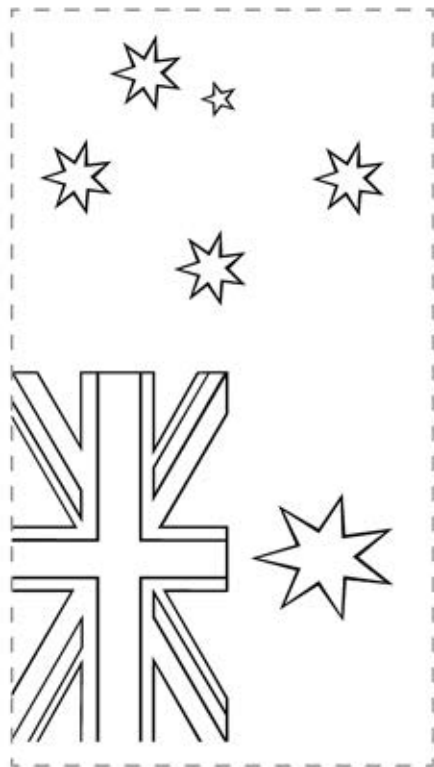
Which of these 3 animals belong in the reef?

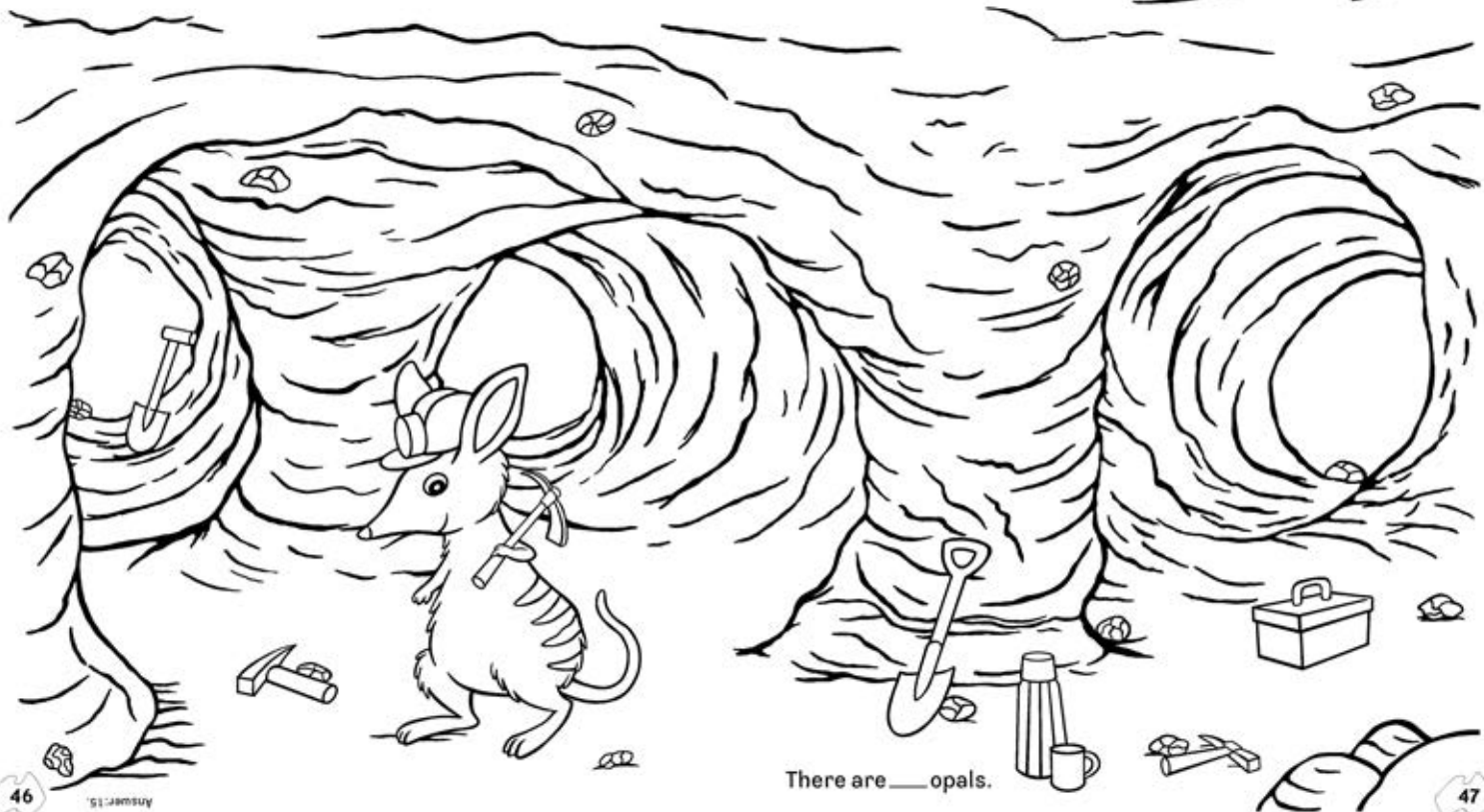
